



MORE2Dance Operating and Safety Protocol for COVID-19 Pandemic Updated December 31, 2021

- M2D Parent Lobby is CLOSED until further notice.
- MORE2Dance will follow public health orders, per [County Guidelines](#), masks will be requested to be worn by dancers, parents, and M2D staff regardless of vaccination status.
- If a dancer has COVID-19 they have to follow the Eagle County Health Guidelines for quarantining. <https://covid19.colorado.gov/isolation-and-quarantine>
- All students will be visually and verbally screened by M2D staff for the following symptoms prior to entering the premises: headache, sore throat, fever, dry cough, recent inability to taste or smell, shortness of breath, body aches, fatigue, diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain. If your child has any of these symptoms they will not be allowed to be at dance.
- Sanitizing spray and hand sanitizer will be available at the entrances to and throughout the studio.
- Students must bring their own water bottles and mask.
- Staff will disinfect all common surfaces (e.g. door knobs, counter surfaces) before and after every class. Extra time will be provided between classes to allow for thorough sanitation of all equipment and surfaces.
- All students must comply with hand-washing protocols and will refrain from entering the building if they are experiencing any of the pre-screen symptoms listed above.
